CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Reider called the Davison County Board of Commissioners meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Kiner, Blaalid and Chairman Reider. Also present was Auditor Wingert. Absent was Commissioner Nebelsick.

PLEDGE

Commissioner Reider opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVE AGENDA

APPROVE MINUTES

Superintendent Weinberg stated that the bridge on 258th/399th Street was set to be repaired in 2026; however, due to some changes within the contracting company, they are able to start working on it this year. Motion by Kiner to allow Chairman Reider to sign off on the bridge repair, seconded by Claggett. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.
