AURORA COUNTY COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

February 16, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by Chairman Clyde Dethlefsen with Randy Niles, Roger Hanten, John Paul Studeny, and Travis Clark present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

There was no public input.

The agenda was amended by adding Tri-State Emergency Management Association meeting and membership.

A motion was made by Clark, seconded by Studeny to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried all voting aye.

A motion was made by Studeny, seconded by Clark to approve the minutes of the February 2^{nd} regular meeting. Motion carried all voting aye.

Emergency Manager Skyler Kehn made a request to become a member of the Tri-State Emergency Management Association which consists of Emergency Managers, Sioux Falls National Weather Service, and SD National Guard in the tri-state area. The annual dues are \$25 and they hold quarterly meetings/trainings. There is a meeting on March 1st in Sioux Falls that he would like to attend. A motion was made by Clark, seconded by Studeny to authorize Emergency manager Kehn to become a member of the Tri-State Emergency Association and attend the meeting on March 1st. Motion carried all voting aye.

Highway Secretary Nancy Beckman was present for the Highway report.

Nancy reported on the RAISE grant that was talked about at the last regular meeting. She stated that the deadline for the application is February 28, 2023. After speaking with District III and the engineer, it was recommended to wait on submitting the application due to the fast-approaching deadline. Nancy stated that the proposed 22-mile project to fix Highway 16 is too much for the engineers to get their work all done before the deadline. It was noted that this grant program will more than likely be available next year and our chances of getting the project funded by this grant will be better if we take the time to get things right rather than rush into it.

A motion was made by Studeny, seconded by Clark to accept with regret the resignation from Cheryl Dethlefsen as Custodian effective March 3, 2023. The Commission thanked her for her service and her time with the county. Motion carried all voting aye. The Commission directed the Auditor to begin advertising for a custodian.

A motion was made by Hanten, seconded by Niles to enter into executive session with Cheryl Dethlefsen at 9:38 AM for personnel as per SDCL 1-25-2(1). Motion carried all voting aye. The Chairman declared the Board out of executive session at 9:53 AM with no official action taken.

State Auditor Brandie Pitts from SD Legislative Audit held a closing conference with the Commission for the County's audit for fiscal years of 2020 and 2021. She noted that everything went well and there would be no written comments.

Sheriff Roman Briggs presented options for graphic designs for the new patrol vehicle (pickup). Roman requested the reflective graphic for safety reasons because it is more visible. A motion was made by Studeny, seconded by Clark to authorize the sheriff's department to purchase the reflective graphics and other necessary equipment for the sheriff's Ford F150 pickup. Motion carried all voting aye.

Sheriff Briggs informed the Commission that the County is being billed for two dogs that were housed at Pleasant Lake Vet Clinic. He told the Board that he did not feel we should be paying the bill just because the county was called to pick them up due to the owner or family members not being able to care for them. A motion was made by Hanten, seconded by Studeny to deny payment and have the vet clinic send the bill to the owner. Commissioner Hanten rescinded the motion due to the matter not being placed on the agenda beforehand, therefore no official action could be taken. The Auditor was directed to have it placed on the agenda for the next meeting.

States Attorney Rachel Mairose asked for authorization to sign a settlement agreement on a class action lawsuit against distributors of opioids. Mairose stated that companies who are named in the lawsuit are paying money back to the State. If the county signs the agreement, we would be allocated some funds. The funds we receive are to be used for opioid remediation, if not, they are to be sent back. Rachel stated that she is looking into the possibilities of having a speaker come to the county, such as Angela Kennecke, or do a marketing campaign on the dangers of opioids. She said she will also reach out to the local healthcare facilities and the County Health Board to see what their suggestions are on how to use the funds. Currently the county has received a total of \$1,358. A motion was

made by Clark, seconded by Niles to authorize States Attorney Mairose to sign the settlement agreement. Motion carried all voting aye.

A motion was made by Studeny, seconded by Clark to enter into executive session at 10:36 AM as per SDCL 1-25-2(1) for personnel with States Attorney Mairose. Motion carried all voting aye. The Chairman declared the Commission out of executive session at 11:09 AM with no official action taken.

A motion was made by Studeny, seconded by Clark to file reports and pay vouchers as listed below.

Motion carried with Niles, Hanten, Studeny, and Clark all voting aye. Commissioner Dethlefsen abstained from the vote.
